HISTORY

In the early 20th century, Wabash native Mark C. Honeywell developed the first hot water heating systems and automatic thermostats in North America. Industrial ingenuity catapulted his small hometown company into the Fortune 500 Corporation known today as Honeywell, Inc.

Mr. Honeywell was regarded as one of the most successful industrialists of his day, but was equally passionate about philanthropy and the arts as he was about business. In 1941, he founded The Honeywell Foundation to oversee the development, construction, and operations of the Honeywell Memorial Community Center (now known as the Honeywell Center) in downtown Wabash, IN. Originally a combination gym and performing arts theatre, Mr. Honeywell designed the arts and community amenities to be “ever useful” to the residents of northern Indiana.

Today, The Honeywell Foundation owns and operates six unique venues throughout the Wabash area – Honeywell Center, Honeywell House, Eagles Theatre, 13-24 Drive In, Charley Creek Gardens, and Dr. James Ford Historic Home. All of the venues, and the countless community-centered programs held at each one throughout the year, uphold Mr. Honeywell’s original vision of “artistic, social, cultural, and recreational opportunities for all.”

Since acquiring and saving the historic Eagles Theatre in 2010, The Honeywell Foundation has been blessed with the gifts of the Honeywell House, Dr. James Ford Historic Home, Charley Creek Gardens, and use of the 13-24 Drive-In. Adding these venues to the amenities already offered at the Honeywell Center, The Foundation reaffirmed its commitment to Mark C. Honeywell's original vision of providing "artistic, cultural, social, and recreational opportunities for all" in facilities which are "ever useful" to the residents of Wabash and the State of Indiana.

In 2018, the Board of Directors, Key Donors, Community Leaders, and Staff Leadership worked together to create an ambitious vision and strategy for continued growth and excellence. This strategy builds upon Honeywell's strengths - high quality visual and performing arts programming, innovative and expansive educational outreach, and beautifully maintained historic facilities. The 3-year plan adds intentional focus on 3 main areas:

- Strategic collaborations with community and regional partners that will diversify our regional impact, and assist The Honeywell Foundation in becoming a provider of choice in arts and entertainment, education and outreach, and hospitality.

For example:

- Over the past several years, Honeywell entered into several strategic partnerships with entertainment venues throughout the region. Staying true to Mr. Honeywell's entrepreneurial spirit, we are leveraging our staff's experience and expertise in booking high caliber entertainment, marketing, sales, and providing excellent customer service to a greater number of people throughout the area. By expanding and strengthening our regional influence, Honeywell is improving our negotiating and buying power with artists and entertainers. In turn, this innovative approach provides the opportunity to continue to bring topnotch entertainment to the Honeywell Center.
- Becoming an employer of choice by improving talent attraction, increasing staff engagement, and creating a culture marked by team spirit and contagious pride in the programs and services offered. Steps taken toward this initiative in 2018 included:
 - Defining The Foundation's core values - Teamwork, Innovation, Excellence, Service, and Stewardship;
 - Modernizing and formalizing employee recruitment processes; and
 - Improving new hire orientation, formalizing a new manager-training program, and implementing a new internal leadership-training program.
 - Improving operating margins by leveraging Honeywell's experience in live entertainment promotions, growing our donor base, securing new grant funding for appropriate programs, increasing utilization and sales in hospitality, and successfully re-launching the newly restored Eagles Theatre.

For over 75 years, Honeywell has provided unparalleled facilities, service, and quality of life programming. The Board of Directors and Management Team believes the strategic plan created in 2018 is aggressive but achievable. We are fully committed to its implementation and success. In doing so, we believe The Foundation will continue to make a highly visible and sustained contribution to the overall betterment of the community, while also making the City of Wabash a destination point for visitors from all regions of the United States and beyond.

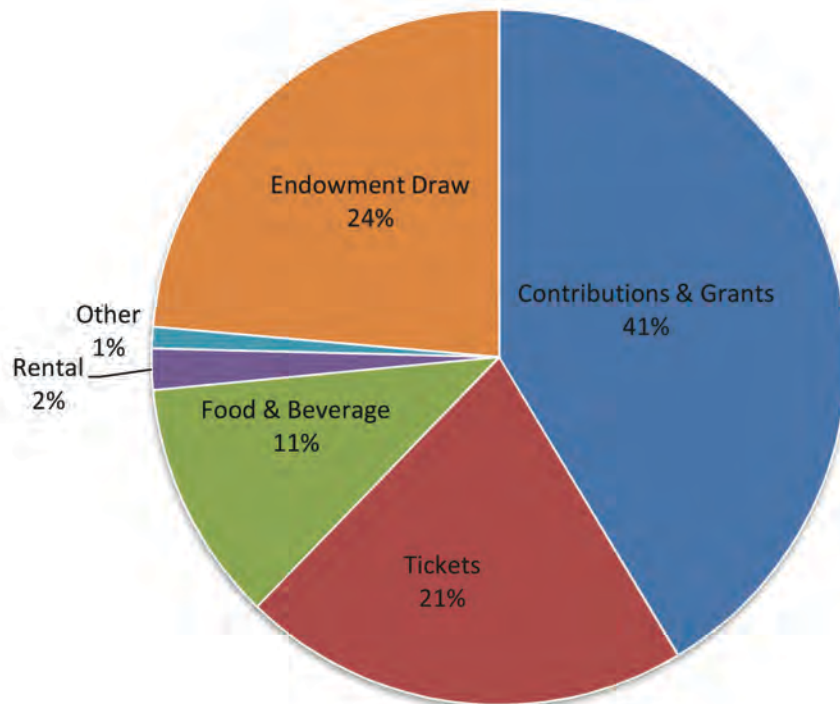

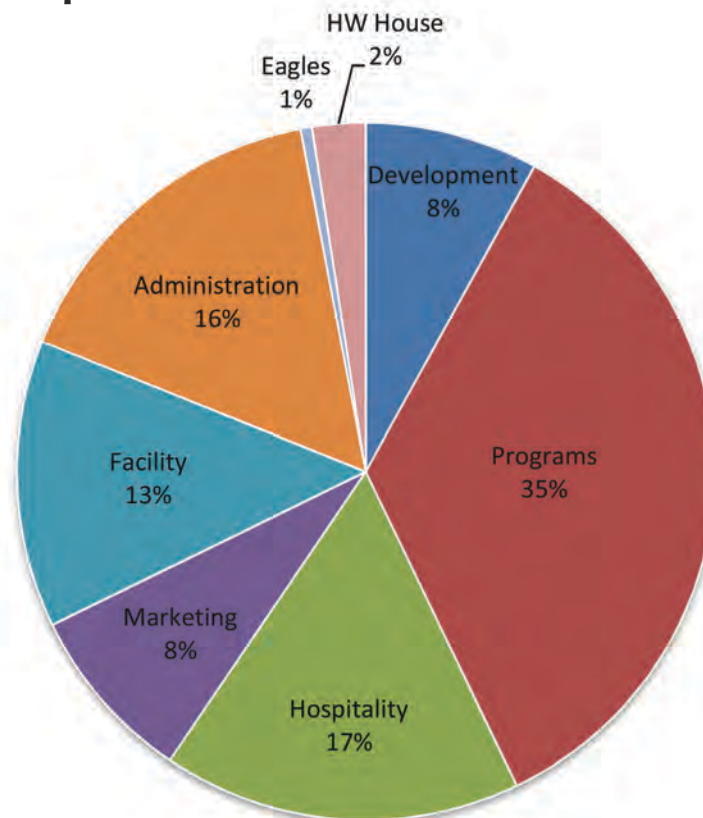
