Looking Forward: Another 75 Years?

In 2016, the Honeywell Foundation marked its 75th Anniversary. One would have to admit that 75 years is quite an achievement. That's three quarters of a century!

When the Foundation was created in 1941, work on the Honeywell Center had only begun. This landmark opened in phases with the gym/theater first opening in 1947, the skating rink in 1949 and, eventually, the entire building was dedicated in 1952. Upon dedication, Mark Honeywell remarked "may it ever be useful" – a mantra that has been taken to heart for the ensuing decades.

During its storied history, the Honeywell Foundation has overseen exciting developments such as the addition of the Ford Theater in the 1990s. This addition greatly enhanced our ability to serve a broader audience. Other developments included the creation of the Educational Outreach Program which now provides more than 49,000

opportunities for students to learn about the arts.

In more recent years, the Foundation has increased its ability to serve through the addition of venues and programs that provide enrichment to thousands. These additions include Wabash Valley Music Association, the Eagles Theatre, Honeywell House, the 13-24 Drive In, Visual Performing Arts Program, ArtsFest, the Dr. James Ford Historic Home and Charley Creek Gardens.

We have grown over the years because of the guiding principle outlined in our mission: "The Honeywell Foundation is a public charity dedicated to the enhancement of artistic, social, cultural, and recreational opportunities for all." The last 75 years have provided countless opportunities. Moving forward into the future, I am confident that our mission will guide us to even newer and better ways in which to serve the public. So, here's to the next 75 years!
