Dear friends,

2021 was another year of great highs and lows. While the beginning of the year found us still working through the difficulties of the pandemic – the year finished strong! Live events returned, in-person activities resumed and the arts were alive and well.

Over the last two years, the appreciation of the importance of art in our lives magnified. The arts inspire and uplift; connect and engage; enliven and entertain. The arts provide for self-expression. And, the arts can make learning fun.

These are not empty statements. We have proof!

- **In 2021, we once again opened our doors to live entertainment.** The joy of connection – to enjoy a favorite performer; laugh with a funny comedian; watch in awe of the acrobatics and dance moves of touring troupes – was a rediscovered treasure. Audiences joined with their friends and family and rejoiced in the ability to be entertained.

- **Eagles Theatre reopened to the grand scale envisioned in early 2020.** Movies, music lessons, banquets and gatherings, live concerts and a grand gala were all featured.

- **Special new initiatives took place to provide an outlet for self-expression for new audiences.** Artes Latinas en Wabash featured visual art from Latino artists. The We the Many artist residency created new opportunities for Latino students in local schools. In addition the Honeywell Arts Academy expanded from one week to three last summer. It has a bright future indeed!

- **Arts in Education activities returned in a big way.** Teaching artists visited classrooms and used their talents in music, song and dramatic arts to teach core curriculum in more than 93 classrooms. Trained facilitators used Visual Thinking Strategies to advance critical thinking skills for 3rd, 4th, and 5th graders in 77 classrooms; including four classrooms where the program was presented in both Spanish and English to increase language skills. In addition to these in-school programs, our education program featured art exhibits, page-to-stage matinees, and a high school media arts program.

The last two years reminded us just how integral the arts are in our everyday lives. One thing we did not need reminded of – is how important our donors are. We have long known how vital our donors are to the success of our organization. At the end of the day we endured the pandemic because of your generosity! Your support makes all the programs of Honeywell Arts & Entertainment possible. Our success is your success.

We thank you wholeheartedly for your loyalty, generosity and dedication. We know that 2022 will provide even more reasons for celebration.

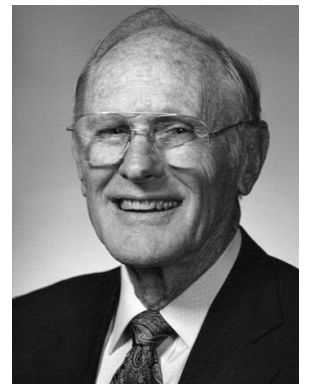
